Travel from the airport to the hotel (please note: The hotel does not provide shuttle service).

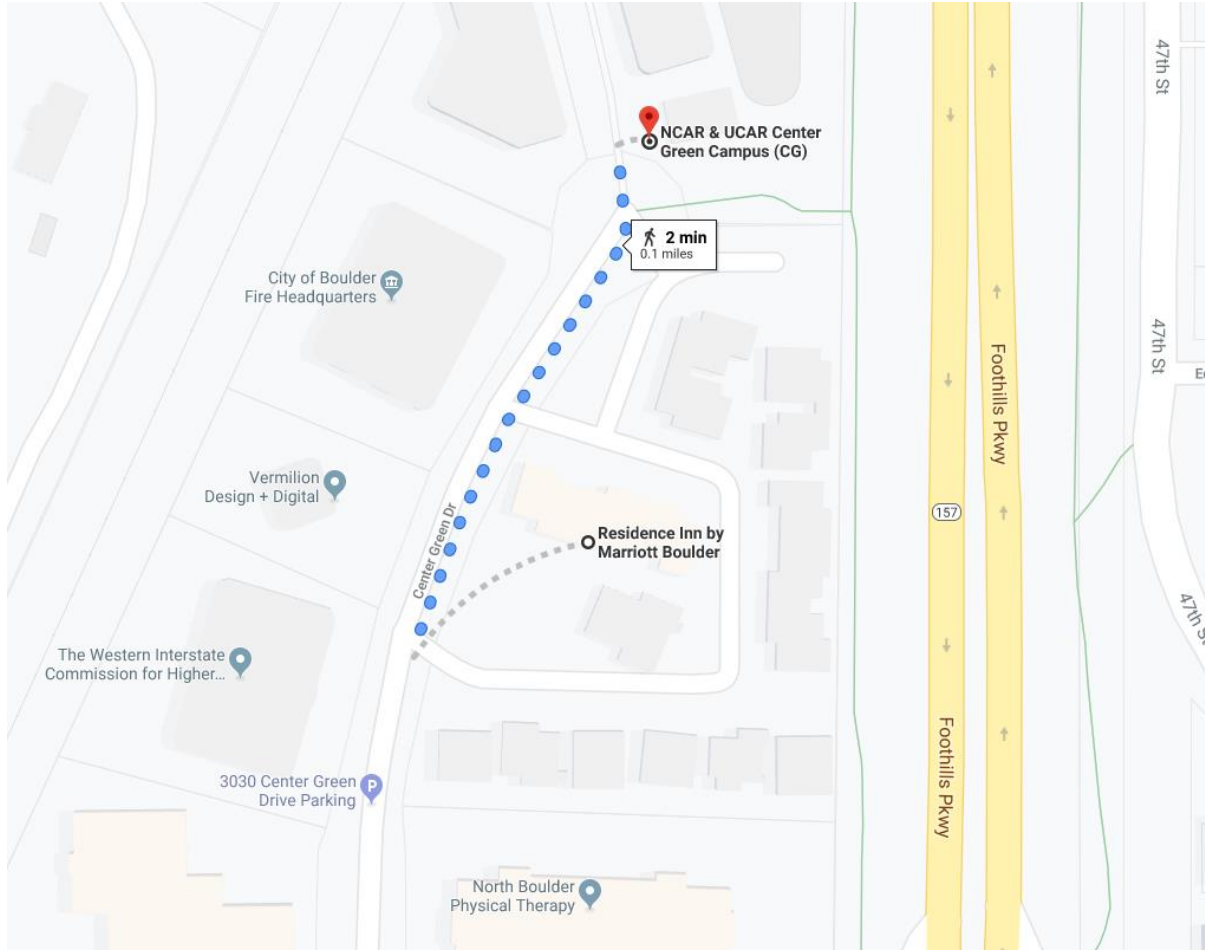

Process for Reimbursement

The UM Partnership fund will reimburse eligible attendees of the workshop for airfare (economy class only) and accommodation (maximum £100 per night). Accommodation will be covered for the night of 27th January to 31st January (four nights). A workshop dinner (also funded by the UM Partnership) will be held for all attendees on Wednesday 29th January 2020.

Individual claims to a personal bank account

For individuals claiming air fare to their **own personal bank account**, please complete the claim form electronically (this will be emailed to eligible attendees). Please scan in all relevant receipts (such as the booking confirmation with the total airfare displayed) and email this along with the claim form to Shannon Jackson (scienceprogrammedeliveryteam@metoffice.gov.uk). If converting to Sterling (or another currency that is different to the one in which the transaction took place) please include evidence of the exchange rates used (otherwise the www.xe.com historic rate will be applied). Please note that Australian and Indian nationals will also need to complete their home address in order for the claim to be processed.

Please submit claims for reimbursement **no later than 08th March 2020** in order for your claim to be processed.
