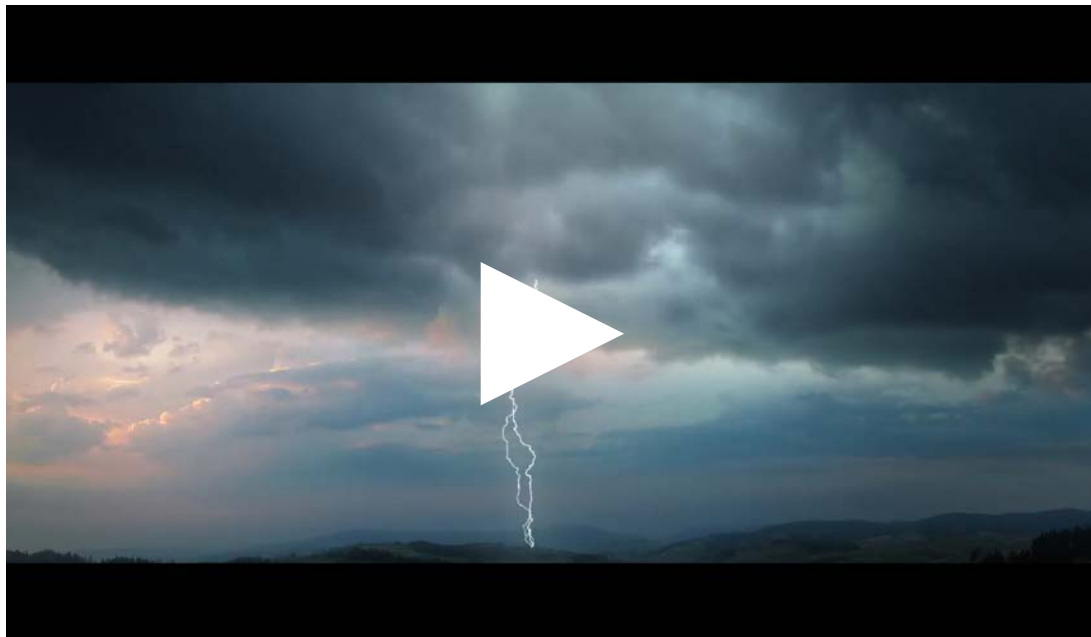

Planning for extreme weather: prompt questions

- What, when, where, why?
- How different was it to normal local weather events?
- Were there any warning signs?
- Was a warning put out? Could it have been put out sooner?
- What risks need to be managed?
- What did people do before, during and after to mitigate the risks?
- How did the emergency services respond?
- Did anything make responding to the situation more difficult?
- What technology is available to help now?
- Is climate change influencing the severity/frequency of this type of event?
